### Nant Plas Crug – Volunteers needed!

GAG has an on-going commitment to remove litter from Nant Plas Crug. The quality of the water has improved recently but problems with the build up of silt and excess plant growth have led to some stagnation. Each summer inevitably brings an increase in litter which not only looks disgusting but adds to the problem. There is some indication that numbers of plastic bags have decreased following the WAG policy decision to implement a charge for these. Though CCC has sprayed the vigorous plant growth most years, the mild autumns have resulted in rapid regrowth. This, together with an increasing depth of silt has led to a much reduced water flow rate (see photos).



Despite some stagnation the basic ecology of the nant still seems to be good, with a food chain supporting sticklebacks providing for a kingfisher and heron. GAG would like to see the nant dredged to maintain its long-term viability and enhance Plas Crug Avenue. Some dredging at the town end, in front of the grill was done recently, at the time of the floods, to alleviate the threatened flooding at the school end. Unfortunately this has led to further blockages back along the nant. Large mats of aquatic plants have been uprooted and are forming a significant barrier to the water flow (see photos).



It is hoped that, following the recent floods, the WAG will find funding to dredge several ditches and streams, including Nant Plas Crug. At least some good may then have resulted from the flood disaster. Volunteers are requested to join the litter removal rota. (all equipment supplied and activity fully explained)
