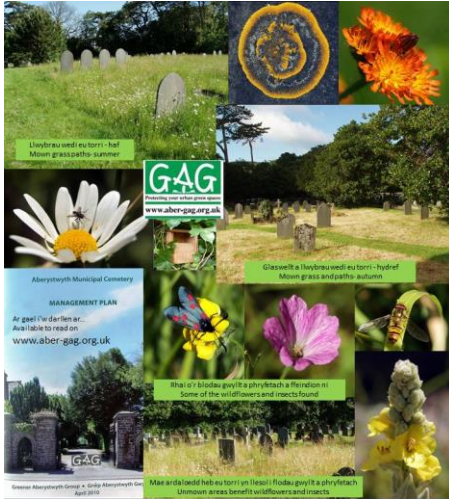

The cemetery: a haven for wildlife



With financial help from Ceredigion C.C., GAG designed a photo collage for the cemetery notice-board to help explain the wildlife-friendly management of the cemetery with pictures of some of the flowers and insects that have benefited from this plan.

Parc y Llyn pond regeneration



GAG members helped CCC officers to clear willow and other shrubs that had invaded the pond in Parc y Llyn. The liner had failed and the pond had dried out, disastrous for the frogs that usually breed in it. The pond has now been restored: It has been carefully widened, re-profiled and a new underlay and liner put in place. Native aquatic plants will be added. A temporary fence has been erected to protect the area whilst the vegetation recovers.

Problem plantings

There have recently been examples of “memorial planting” by individuals in unsuitable places, or using unsuitable plants. Planting non-native plants in a nature reserve is clearly problematic. GAG encourages people to contact the relevant authorities who could advise on a suitable site, suitable choice of plant, etc.

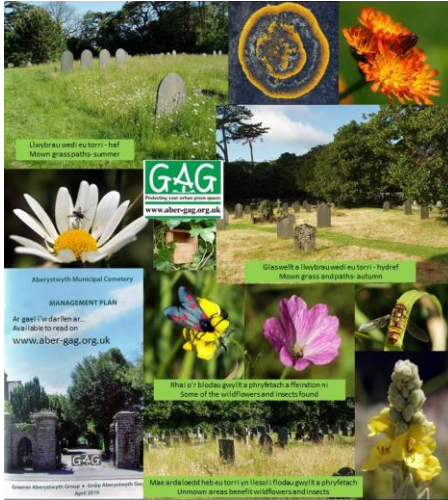
